



RULEBOOK PHOTO CONTEST THE WORLD TEACHES US

1. PROMOTERS

The photo contest **The world teaches us**, in its first edition, is promoted by ICEI, Institute for Economic Development Cooperation, and will take place from 5 October to 19 November 2021.

This competition is not subject to ministerial authorization pursuant to the D.P.R. n. 430 of 26/10/2001, article 6. Participation is subject to registration which must be made by sending your participation via the website www.icei.it/theworldteachesus or to the email address contest@icei.it.

2. THEME

The aim of this contest is to raise awareness among people and citizens on the importance, richness and uniqueness of reciprocal and circular teachings: the world and other people, those different from us, speak to us and transmit small or great teachings in life.

Every experience, every human interaction, every journey near or far, is a way to discover the world and other people, experience diversity, value differences, learn and grow. Through this contest we want to collect the faces, the smiles, the looks of the people who have taught us something significant, meaningful or particular in life: it could have been during one of your travels, in a meeting, in your daily life, in a peculiar situation while with your family, at work, with friends.

It can be a saying, a teaching, a culinary habit or a recipe, a way of greeting, a behaviour or a habit, a value, the knowledge of a fruit or a flower, a story from one's past. People who taught us a new way of being in the world, looking at the sky, living work, nurturing a passion, understanding nature, relating with others, walking barefoot or dancing: the world talks to us and teaches us every day in the most different ways.

Through the activities we carry out every day, we at ICEI know that enhancing the enormous wealth of knowledge, experiences and cultures of our planet is an invaluable resource for building a fair, supportive, inclusive and sustainable world. Being active in international cooperation means, for us, giving life to a reciprocal and circular exchange of knowledge with people from all the countries we come into contact with. We are convinced that a local solution can virtuously transform itself into a global model and vice versa. Every single knowledge enriches the collective cultural baggage, in all directions.

3. HOW TO PARTICIPATE

Participation in the contest is free and open to everyone: non-professional photographers, amateurs or professionals.

Each participant can send a maximum of 3 photos together with the description of each photo, which deepen the THEME of the photo contest as indicated in point 2) of these Regulations, and the registration form duly completed and signed.

The description of each photo must be of a maximum length of 300 characters (including spaces), explaining in a summary way how this person and/or experience has managed to teach you something and have an impact in your life.

Members of the jury and their family members are excluded from the competition.

4. IMAGE TECHNICAL FEATURES

B/W and colour photographs with both vertical and horizontal frames are allowed, in JPEG (.jpg) or PNG format. Works entirely made on computer or videos are not allowed. We ask you to send us photos in square format (1080x1080px) or, if not, we will arrange the formatting.

5. HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR WORK

The submission of the works, together with the duly completed registration form, must take place by November 19 through the website www.icei.it/theworldteachesus or by email at contest@icei.it.

In case of submission via email, the following information must be provided:

- Photo
- Description: "This person (with possible name) taught me ..."
- Place of shooting
- Personal data of the participant: name, surname, full address, short biography, Instagram channel or Facebook page (if any)

6. PRIZES

The two best photos, with relative descriptions, will obtain the following awards:

1st BEST PHOTO/STORY: participation in a one-week travel experience in Mozambique, together with ICEI staff, visiting the cooperation projects active in the country.

2nd BEST PHOTO/STORY: scholarship to cover the costs for participation in the Responsible Tourism Course, organized by AITR - Italian Association for Responsible Tourism.

7. JURY

The jury is composed by professionals from the photographic and journalistic sectors and will express an unquestionable judgment. Together with the jury's vote, the online vote on ICEI's social channels ([Instagram](#) e [Facebook](#)) will also be used for the evaluation of the winning photo.

8. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Each participant is responsible for the material he/she submits to the contest. Therefore you undertake to exclude any responsibility of the organizers of the aforementioned towards third parties, and also towards any subjects depicted in the photographs. The participant must inform any interested parties (people portrayed) in the cases and in the manner provided for by Legislative Decree June 30, 2003 n. 196, as well as obtaining consent for the dissemination of the same. In no case will the images sent contain data that can be classified as sensitive. Each participant also declares to be the sole author of the images sent and that they are original, that do not require third party rights and that if they portray subjects for which consent or authorization is required, he has obtained it. The organizers also reserve the right to exclude from the competition and not to publish the photos that do not comply in the form and subject with what is indicated in these Regulations or with the commonly recognized rules on public morality, ethics and decency, for the protection of participants and visitors. Therefore, images deemed offensive, improper and harmful to human and social rights will not be admitted.

9. COPYRIGHT AND USE OF CONTEST MATERIAL

The rights to the photos remain exclusive property of the author who produced them, who authorizes their use for events or publications related to the contest itself and for activities relating to the institutional purposes or to raise awareness of the contest partners, in any case without the purpose for profit. Each author is personally responsible for the works presented. Unless expressly prohibited in writing, the organization is authorized to reproduce in catalogues, publications and on non-profit online channels with mention of the author's name. Each time they are used, the photos will be accompanied by the name of the author and, where possible, by any explanatory notes indicated by the same. We inform you that the

personal data provided by the participants will be used for activities relating to the institutional or promotional purposes in accordance with the provisions of Legislative Decree no. June 30, 2003 n. 196. The material sent will not be returned.
